

DIOCESAN BUSINESS MANAGER RESPONSIBILITIES ORDINANCE 2011

WHEREAS the Diocesan Business Manager is appointed in accordance with the Diocesan Management Ordinance 2003, and

WHEREAS by virtue of that appointment the Diocesan Business Manager becomes a member of a number of Diocesan boards and committees, and

WHEREAS a review of the role of the Diocesan Business Manager indicates the benefit in reducing the number of ex-officio appointments, and

WHEREAS the mechanism for making such changes requires an Ordinance

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED AND RULED by the Diocesan Council in accordance with the Synod (Delegation of Powers) Ordinance 2009 and exercising the Powers vested in it by the Anglican Church of Australia Trust Property Act 1917, as follows

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the “Diocesan Business Manager Responsibilities Ordinance 2011”.
2. The Storm Village Constitution Ordinance 1990 is amended by
 - a. Repealing section 4(a)(iii).
 - b. In section 4(a)(v) deleting the word “two” and inserting in its place the word “three.”
3. The Anglican Care (Diocese of Newcastle) Ordinance 2007 is amended by
 - a. Repealing section 6(c).
 - b. In section 6(d) deleting the word “three” and inserting in its place the word “four”.
4. The Clergy Emoluments Advisory Board Ordinance 1979 is amended by
 - a. In section 5 deleting the words “Diocesan Manager of the Diocese of Newcastle” and inserting in their place the words “Diocesan Business Manager or a person appointed by the Diocesan Business Manager to attend in his or place”.
5. The Cathedral Ordinance 1995 is amended by
 - a. In clause 13 deleting the words “(b) the Diocesan Manager”
 - b. In clause 13 deleting the words “(c) Three” and inserting in their place the words “(b) Four”.
6. The Diocesan Management Ordinance 2003 is amended by
 - a. Deleting the words “the Diocesan Manager” wherever they occur and inserting in their place the words “the Diocesan Business Manager”.
 - b. Deleting the words “Bishop in Council” wherever they occur and inserting in their place the words “Diocesan Council”.
 - c. Deleting all the words in section 7 and inserting in their place the words “Whenever an Act of Parliament, Constitution, Canon or Ordinance refers to the office of the Registrar of the Diocese of Newcastle it shall be construed as a reference to the Diocesan Business Manager.”
