

ST JOHN'S HINTON AND ALL SAINTS WOODVILLE PERMANENT TRUST ORDINANCE 2011

AN ORDINANCE to vary the sum of trusts unallocated for the Parish of Morpeth arising from the sale of St John's Church, Hinton and All Saints Church, Woodville.

AND WHEREAS St John's Church, Hinton and All Saint's Church, Woodville have been sold and the proceeds of such sale held by the Trustees subject to such further determination by the Synod of the Diocese of Newcastle.

AND WHEREAS the Parish of Morpeth have consented to the variation of the trusts set out in **Schedule One** to provide such funds for the maintenance of St James' Church Morpeth and the Rectory at Morpeth.

BE IT ENACTED by the Bishop and Diocesan Council of the Diocese of Newcastle pursuant to the **Synod (Delegation of Powers) Ordinance 2009** and every other power hereunto enabling as follows:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Morpeth - St John's Hinton and All Saints Woodville Permanent Trust Ordinance 2011".
2. The proceeds of the sale of St John's, Hinton and All Saints, Woodville as set out in the **Schedule One** hereto shall be applied for the benefit of the Parish of Morpeth upon the following terms and conditions.
 - a. A Permanent Trust is created to be known as, "The Morpeth - St John's Hinton and All Saints Woodville Permanent Trust."
 - b. The income arising upon such trust shall be applied in the following manner
 - i. 20% shall be capitalized, and
 - ii. the balance shall be applied for the purpose of maintaining the buildings known as St James' Church Morpeth and the Rectory for the Parish of Morpeth.
 - c. To come into effect from 1st July 2010.
