

## **THE CHRIST CHURCH CATHEDRAL LAND SALES (VARIATION OF TRUST) ORDINANCE 2013**

### **Explanatory Memorandum**

The Glebe land was sold in 1921 and the proceeds have been drawn on from time to time for matters relating to the Cathedral. The variation in trust ensures that capital and interest are available for unfunded works on the deanery, desalination work on cathedral walls (at the west end), urgent work on cathedral lighting and urgent repairs and investigations on the rose window.

### **Ordinance**

Whereas the Synod by ordinance authorised the sale of certain lands known as the Cathedral Glebe Land on 7 July 1921 and whereas by ordinances in 1923, 1940 and 1962 it amended the trusts by which the funds were held and utilised, and

Whereas the Diocesan Council exercising the powers of the Synod in accordance with the Church Trust Property Ordinance 2012 has deemed it inexpedient to continue those trusts

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE DIOCESAN COUNCIL** in accordance with the provisions of the Church Trust Property Ordinance 2012 as follows

1. This Ordinance maybe cited as the Christ Church Cathedral Land Sales (Variation of Trust) Ordinance 2013.
2. The funds held by the Trustees in the account known as the Cathedral Glebe Account P0321 are held for the purposes of building and maintenance works on buildings held in trust for the Cathedral parish.
3. The capital and interest on the capital may be drawn by resolution of the Cathedral Board.

### **Motion arising**

That the funds held in the Cathedral Glebe Account P0321 be transferred to a temporary trust.
