

## STOCKTON CHURCH LANDS VESTING ORDINANCE 2014

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Bishop and Diocesan Council of the Anglican Diocese of Newcastle pursuant to the **Synod (Delegation of Powers) Ordinance 2009 and the Church Trust Property Ordinance 2012** as follows:

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Stockton Church Lands Vesting Ordinance 2014.
2. In this Ordinance the land shall mean the church trust property being all the real property comprised in the said Certificate of Title Volume 5202 Folio 117 ("**Land**") which has been certified by the Bishop as being held on trust for the Diocese in accordance with section 34 of the *Anglican Church of Australia Trust Property Act 1917 (NSW)* ("**Act**") – Annexure A.
3. By reason of circumstances which have arisen after the creation of the trusts on which the Land is held, it has become expedient to vest the Land in the Trustees of Church Property for the Diocese of Newcastle in accordance with section 19 of the Act.
4. The consent of the Synod is hereby given to Land being vested in the Trustees of Church Property for the Diocese of Newcastle and, accordingly, the Land is hereby vested in the Trustees of Church Property.

**I HEREBY CERTIFY** the Ordinance as printed is in accordance with the Ordinance as reported.
