

## THE ANGLICAN CARE INCORPORATION ORDINANCE 2006

**AN ORDINANCE** to constitute the members of the Board of Anglican Care, a Body Corporate pursuant to the provisions of the *Anglican Church of Australia (Bodies Corporate) Act 1938 (NSW)*.

**BE IT THEREFORE** ordained and ruled by the Bishop, Clergy and Laity of the Diocese of Newcastle in Synod assembled as follows:

### BACKGROUND

- A. Anglican Care has been established pursuant to the provisions of the *C. A. Brown Anglican Village Ordinance 1995* for the establishment of diocesan homes for aged people.
- B. Anglican Care has been established to apply any surplus funds pursuant to the provisions of the *C. A. Brown Anglican Village Ordinance 1995*.
- C. A Board known as Anglican Care has been constituted by the authority of an Ordinance of the Synod of the Diocese of Newcastle for the purpose of managing, governing and controlling Anglican Care of the Anglican Church of Australia.
- D. It is expedient for the purpose of managing, governing and controlling Anglican Care that the Members of the Board be constituted as a Body Corporate.

### PART 1 – PRELIMINARY

#### Short Title

1. This Ordinance may be cited for all purposes as the *Anglican Care Incorporation Ordinance 2006*.

#### Object and Purpose

2. It is expedient for the purpose of managing, governing or controlling an institution known as Anglican Care, being an institution of the Anglican Church of Australia, that the persons who for the time being are the members of an unincorporated body known as Anglican Care should be constituted a body corporate under the name Anglican Care herein called the Board.
3. The object and purpose of the Board are to manage, govern or control Anglican Care.
