

BISHOP TYRRELL ANGLICAN COLLEGE INCORPORATION ORDINANCE 1999

AN ORDINANCE to constitute the members of Bishop Tyrrell Anglican College Council a Body Corporate pursuant to the provisions of the Anglican Church of Australia [Bodies Corporate] Act 1938.

WHEREAS Bishop Tyrrell Anglican College has been established to provide educational facilities in the Archdeaconry of Newcastle and a Council known as Bishop Tyrrell Anglican College Council has been established to manage the said school AND WHEREAS it is expedient for the purpose of managing, governing or controlling Bishop Tyrrell Anglican College that the members of Bishop Tyrrell Anglican College Council should be constituted a body corporate.

BE IT THEREFORE ordained and ruled by the Bishop, Clergy and Laity of the Diocese of Newcastle in Synod assembled as follows:

PART 1 – PRELIMINARY

Short Title

1. This Ordinance may be cited for all purposes as the **Bishop Tyrrell Anglican College Incorporation Ordinance 1999.**

PART 2 - OPERATIVE PART

- 2. It is expedient for the purpose of managing, governing and controlling an institution known as Bishop Tyrrell Anglican College [being an institution of the Anglican Church of Australia] that the persons who for the time being are the members of an unincorporated body known as Bishop Tyrrell Anglican College Council should be constituted a body corporate under the name "Bishop Tyrrell Anglican College" herein called the "Council".
- 3. The objects and purposes of the Council are to manage, govern and control Bishop Tyrrell Anglican College.
