

LAKES GRAMMAR – AN ANGLICAN SCHOOL INCORPORATION ORDINANCE 2004

AN ORDINANCE to constitute the members of the Lakes Grammar – An Anglican School Board a Body Corporate pursuant to the provisions of the Anglican Church of Australia (Bodies Corporate) Act 1938.

WHEREAS the Lakes Grammar – An Anglican School (formerly referred to as Warnervale Anglican Grammar School) has been established to provide educational facilities and the Board of the said School has been established to manage the said School,

AND WHEREAS it is expedient for the purpose of managing, governing or controlling the said School that the members of the said Board should be constituted a body corporate.

BE IT THEREFORE ordained and ruled by the Bishop Clergy and Laity of the Diocese of Newcastle in Synod assembled as follows:

PART 1 – PRELIMINARY

Short Title

1. This Ordinance may be cited for all purposes as the ***Lakes Grammar – An Anglican School Incorporation Ordinance 2004.***

PART 2 – OPERATIVE PART

2. It is expedient for the purpose of managing, governing or controlling Lakes Grammar – An Anglican School (being an institution of the Anglican Church of Australia) that the persons who for the time being are the members of an unincorporated body known as the Lakes Grammar Select Committee should be constituted a body corporate under the name of "Lakes Grammar – An Anglican School" herein called the "Board".
3. The objects and purposes of the Board are to manage, govern and control the Lakes Grammar – An Anglican School.
