

CLERGY EMOLUMENTS ADVISORY BOARD ORDINANCE 1979

AN ORDINANCE to repeal the Motor Vehicle Purchases and Travelling Expenses Ordinance of 1946 (as amended) and to amend the Parochial and Diocesan Funds Ordinance of 1959 as amended by deleting in its entirety Clause 13 thereof and to make new provisions for a Board to regulate clergy emoluments.

WHEREAS the Diocesan Council at its meeting on 15th February 1979 gave its authority for the amalgamation of the Stipends Advisory Board and the Parishes Travelling Expenses Board;

BE IT THEREFORE ordained and ruled by the Bishop, Clergy and Laity of the Diocese of Newcastle in Synod assembled as follows:

PART 1 – PRELIMINARY

Short Title

1. This Ordinance may be cited for all purposes as the ***Clergy Emoluments Advisory Board Ordinance 1979.***

PART 2 – OPERATIVE PART

Repeal

2. The whole of the Motor Vehicle Purchases and Travelling Expenses Ordinance 1946 (as amended) is hereby repealed.

3. Amendment

Clause 13 of the Parochial and Diocesan Funds Ordinance of 1959 (as amended) is deleted in its entirety.

4. Clergy Emoluments Advisory Board

A Board herein called Clergy Emoluments Advisory Board is hereby established.

5. Members of the Board

The Board shall consist of:

Two persons appointed by the Bishop of whom one shall be nominated by him as Chairman.

Amended 2011

Diocesan Business Manager or a person appointed by the Diocesan Business Manager to attend in his or her place.

Amended 1991

One layman and two Clergy one of whom shall be from an area of Diocese more than 80 km from Newcastle, appointed by Diocesan Council.

The Board shall be appointed at the first meeting of the Diocesan Council after the 1979 Session of Synod and thereafter at the first meeting of Diocesan Council held after the first session of each Synod. Four members shall form a quorum.

Duties of the Board

6. (a) To recommend to the Diocesan Council:

Amended 2007

- i. The minimum stipends and allowances to be paid to the clergy and diocesan officers.
- ii. The motor vehicle travelling and car depreciation allowances to be paid to Clergy.

- (b) To report to the Diocesan Council as required and at least annually.

Amended 2013

7. A stipend and allowances to be paid to the Bishop and any assistant bishop shall be set out by a committee comprising the Chair of the Emoluments Advisory Board, a Trustee elected by the Trustees following the first session of each Synod and a lay member of the Diocesan Council elected by the Diocesan Council following the first session of each Synod.
