

EPISCOPAL CERTIFICATE ABOLITION ORDINANCE 2013

AN ORDINANCE to prevent the issue of Episcopal Certificates as a means of enabling the provision of capital finances for entities within the Diocese

BE IT THEREFORE Ordained by the Diocesan Council of the Diocese of Newcastle as follows:

PART 1 – PRELIMINARY

Short Title

1. This Ordinance may be cited for all purposes as the ***Episcopal Certificate Abolition Ordinance 2013***.

PART 2 – OPERATIVE PART

2. Sub-title The Capital Needs Financing Ordinance 2009 is repealed.
3. The Bishop shall not issue an Episcopal Certificate or equivalent document as a form of guarantee for a loan.
4. This ordinance shall not affect the validity, legality or undertaking given in any Episcopal Certificate issued in accordance with the Capital Needs Financing Ordinance 1966 or the Capital Needs Financing Ordinance 2009.
