

ST. LUKE'S (SCONE) GRAMMAR SCHOOL COUNCIL INCORPORATION ORDINANCE 1993

AN ORDINANCE to constitute the members of St. Luke's (Scone) Grammar School Council a Body Corporate pursuant to the provisions of the Anglican Church of Australia (Bodies Corporate) Act, 1938.

WHEREAS St. Luke's (Scone) Grammar School has been established to provide educational facilities in the Archdeaconry of the Upper Hunter and a Council known as St. Luke's (Scone) Grammar School Council has been established to manage the said school AND WHEREAS it is expedient for the purpose of managing, governing or controlling St. Luke's (Scone) Grammar School that the members of St. Luke's (Scone) Grammar School Council should be constituted a body corporate.

BE IT THEREFORE ordained and ruled by the Bishop, Clergy and Laity of the Diocese of Newcastle in Synod assembled as follows:

PART 1 – PRELIMINARY

Short Title

1. This Ordinance may be cited for all purposes as the ***St. Luke's (Scone) Grammar School Council Incorporation Ordinance 1993.***

PART 2 – OPERATIVE PART

2. It is expedient for the purpose of managing, governing and controlling an institution known as St. Luke's (Scone) Grammar School (being an institution of the Anglican Church of Australia) that the persons who for the time being are the members of an unincorporated body known as St. Luke's (Scone) Grammar School Council should be constituted a body corporate under the name "St. Luke's (Scone) Grammar School Council" herein called the "Council"
3. The objects and purposes of the Council are to manage, govern and control St. Luke's (Scone).
